Outreach

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 2. 67% of parents and 56% of teachers in US believe students should be required to learn CS.
 3. Only 77 schools in IN (18% of IN schools with AP programs) offered an AP CS course in 2016-17
 4. Universities in Indiana only graduated 1 new teacher prepared to teach CS in 2016.
