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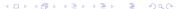

### Diversity

- NCWIT Pacesetter Team for the third time!
- Collaborative plans with Hudson & Holland Scholars Programs and Groups Scholars Program

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  - 2. 67% of parents and 56% of teachers in US believe students should be required to learn CS.
  - Only 77 schools in IN (18% of IN schools with AP programs) offered an AP CS course in 2016-17
  - 4. Universities in Indiana only graduated 1 new teacher prepared to teach CS in 2016.

- ► The Cross Campus Certificate in Entrepreneurship (SICE + Kelley partnership)
- Vibrant ecosystem of student organizations, currently 15

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- Media Cognate (Informatics Program)

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- Computing is integrated into everyday life.
- Data is everywhere and more is being generated every second.

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- 58% of new STEM jobs are in computing.
- ▶ Only 8% of STEM graduates are in Computer Science.
